Westmill Wind Farm Co-operative will build a community-owned wind farm on a former airfield in Watchfield on the border of Oxfordshire and Wiltshire. The project has full planning permission.

Shares in the wind farm are available to anyone across the UK from November 2005. The minimum investment is £250 and the maximum is £20,000. Preference will be given to those who live within 50 miles of the site if the scheme is oversubscribed.

Each member receives one vote regardless of their stake in the project and all members will be eligible for election to the board of Westmill Wind Farm Co-op.

The turbines are expected to become operational in December 2006 and will provide enough 'green' electricity to power more than 2,500 homes. Members will receive annual interest on their shares from the operation of the site.

The project is modelled on the award winning wind farm established by Baywind Energy Co-operative in Cumbria. Baywind is the UK's first and largest community-owned energy project, which is run entirely by its 1,300 members and produces enough energy for 1,400 homes.

Baywind has made share interest payments to its members of around 7% gross per annum since it launched.

Baywind Co-operative has proved that community-owned energy projects can operate successfully and profitably.

Westmill Wind Farm



Westmill Wind Farm is the brainchild of organic farmer Adam Twine, who has spent the last 13 years working to achieve his dream of building a wind farm on his land.



The co-op is run with assistance from Energy4All - a company set up by Baywind in 2002 to facilitate the ownership and operation of renewable energy projects by local or community based co-ops.

The wind farm will help the UK avoid emissions of harmful greenhouse gases, which are produced by burning fossil fuels in conventional power stations. It will also contribute towards the Government's target of generating 10 per cent of electricity from renewable sources by 2010.
